Law of the WTO | January 13 - 27, 2014

Course description:

The course aims to introduce students to the basic principles enshrined in the WTO Agreements, specifically those related to trade in goods and trade in services. The course will start with a brief introduction of the history of the GATT 1947 and the WTO as well as with the organizational framework of the WTO. The course will also offer a general overview of the more specialized courses on the WTO and the relationship of the GATT with other international trade law and policy issues. During the course, the students will be exposed to various case studies to ensure that they are trained for gractice. At the end of the course, it is hoped that the students would be able to critically analyze the compliance of government measures and policies with the GATT 1994 and GATS as well as other covered agreements of the WTO:
